If the requirements are not met by October 15th, your child will be excluded from school until all required paperwork is received. All examinations must have been completed within one year of the first day of school. If physical/immunization requirements are not met within 30 days of all out of state transfer students starting at Eastland, they will be excluded until all required paperwork is received.
