### **ADOPTION OF BOARD OF EDUCATION AGENDA:**

### **COMMUNICATIONS:**

Principal Mahoney congratulated and presented a certificate to 4th grade teacher, Chelsea Hasken, for Teacher Leadership Recognition by the Illinois Principals' Association NW Division. Mahoney read the nomination letter that spoke of Hasken's dedication, leadership and enthusiasm for teaching. Hasken was selected out of 50 nominations to receive the award. Mahoney then introduced and congratulated Kaleb LaRue and later, Cassie Blevins, for student leadership, character and academic achievement in school. Both students are in 5th grade and received a NW Division Illinois Principals' Association Award.

Principal Burkholder also spoke of the high standards set by senior students Kaden Henze and Gabby Snyder, who both received Student Leadership Awards from the Illinois Principals' Association NW Division. They set high goals in academics, extra-curricular activities and leadership.

Dr. Hansen mentioned that the Board packet included a congratulatory note from Sauk Valley Media in regards to Eastland on its "Best High Schools" recognition by the *US News and World Report*.

# > STATUS REPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS (SROs)

Superintendent Hansen shared that both SROs have been busy, useful and very helpful. He did mention that due to confidentiality concerns, he would be sharing more information during Closed Session.

> 1ST READING OF EASTLAND EDUCATION ASSOCIATION PROPOSAL TO APPLY FOR A WAIVER OF SCHOOL CODE TO ALLOW NON-RESIDENT CERTIFIED STAFF MEMBERS TO ENROLL CHILDREN WITHOUT PAYING TUITION, AND APPROVAL TO HOLD A WAIVER HEARING IN JUNE

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Erin Paulsen presented a request from the Eastland Education Association, asking the Board to consider applying for a waiver of school code. The waiver would allow full-time staff who reside out-of-district to enroll their children at Eastland school without paying the out-of-district tuition. The presentation outlined the positive benefits and the impact this could have on future hiring and retention of staff, a priority given the current teacher shortages.

A motion was made by <u>Cassens</u> and seconded by <u>Preston</u> to approve to advertise and hold a waiver hearing of school code 105 ILCS5/10-20.12a, as presented.

Roll call vote showed Cassens, Heldt, Henze, Preston, Snider, Sturtevant, and Waller voting aye. **Motion carried.** 

## > <u>PRESENTATION AND APPROVAL OF THE 2019-20 STAFFING PLAN AT</u> EASTLAND ELEMENTARY

Dr. Hansen presented some options and research information in regards to class sizes and staffing. Various parents from the audience gave feedback, voicing opinions on the benefits they feel students have through smaller class sizes in the lower grades.

A motion was made by <u>Preston</u> and seconded by <u>Cassens</u> to approve the addition of a third section of 2nd grade for the 2019-20 school year, as presented.

# > 1ST READING OF PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE PARENT-STUDENT HANDBOOK FOR 2019-20

Principal Burkholder noted there were no significant changes to the Parent-Student Handbook for 2019-20. She explained that the only non-standardized change was to the scale used in standards-based grading. Approval of the handbook is scheduled for the Regular June Board meeting.

# > APPROVAL TO RENEW THE DISTRICT'S HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019

A motion was made by <u>Henze</u> and seconded by <u>Heldt</u> to approve the District group health plan renewal with Blue Cross/Blue Shield, at the single rate of \$559.18/month, to approve the District group dental, life and voluntary vision insurance plan with Guardian, and to approve changes to the Health Reimbursement Account with reimbursement up to \$3,500 of the deductible or out-of-pocket maximum costs. Reimbursement will be given after the first \$500 is met for each life insured under the district's group health insurance plan during 2019-20, all effective July 1, 2019 as presented.

Roll call vote showed Cassens, Heldt, Henze, Preston, Snider, Sturtevant, and Waller voting aye. **Motion carried.** 

### > 1ST READING OF PROPOSED POLICY REVISIONS

# > APPROVAL OF 3-RIVER PURCHASING CO-OP BIDS FOR BREAD/MILK FOR 2019-20, AND APPROVAL TO LET BIDS FOR FUEL FOR 2019-20

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A motion was made by <u>Heldt</u> and seconded by <u>Preston</u> to approve the 3-River purchasing co-op bids for bread from Aunt Millie's and milk from Enyeart for 2019-20, and to let bids for fuel for the 2019-20 school year, as presented.

- Authorized the Superintendent to work with <u>Cynthia Feltmeyer</u>, Ag Teacher, and the Eastland Education Association to draft a Memorandum of Understanding to augment her 2019-20 compensation so as to apply for matching funds through the FY20 Three Circles Grant
