The Board received the 1st drafts of the 2019-20 Emergency Crisis Plan.

> <u>YEAR END FINANCIAL REPORT</u>

The year-end financial report was shared, showing District revenues coming in higher than expenses for the 2018-19 school year. Superintendent Kashner complimented the Board of Education, former Superintendent Hansen, the staff, and the public for being fiscally responsible and putting the District in great shape financially.

> 1ST READING OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS: BANKING SERVICES

The Board heard a request for proposal in regards to banking services. Kashner gave them some background details of why the request is being made and about a possible process in moving forward. Action will be taken during the regular Board meeting scheduled in August.

> <u>REQUEST TO USE BAND UNIFORMS</u>

Principal Burkholder addressed the Board regarding marching band members from Pearl City renting Eastland band uniforms for the upcoming year. Pearl City would be responsible for the end of the year dry cleaning of uniforms used and any necessary replacement costs.

> <u>APPROVAL OF BOOSTER CLUB REQUEST</u>

A motion was made by <u>Sturtevant</u> and seconded by <u>Preston</u> to approve the Booster Club sponsorship of the Fall Youth Basketball League, as presented.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

Superintendent Kashner provided updates on happenings occurring around the District. 30 students in grades 4-12 attended summer school with 96% of students passing their summer school courses. 43 students attended summer Driver's Education classes. He stated that a big

success of summer Driver's Education classes is that it allows these students to take additional courses during the academic year.

Kashner informed the Board that construction work is progressing well. The new secure entrance and remodeled District office at Elementary School is on schedule to be completed by August 3rd. New carpet has been installed in both the band room and media center at the Jr/Sr High School.
