## **ADOPTION OF BOARD OF EDUCATION AGENDA:**

A motion was made by <u>Heldt</u> and seconded by <u>Preston</u> to approve the agenda as adjusted, adding Personnel action item

Roll call vote showed Cassens, Heldt, Preston, Snider, Sturtevant, and Waller voting aye. **Motion** carried.

## **RECOGNITION OF VISITORS:**

Visitors were welcomed. Mrs. Mindy Hayden spoke to the Board regarding the new wrestling agreement proposal. She asked the Board to consider waiting to decide on the new agreement, to allow time to hear from the student athletes affected by this proposed change. They are passionate about the current program with West Carroll and have worked hard to build themselves within that program since junior high. She informed the Board that her son would be writing a letter, as he was not able to attend due to a wrestling meet. Mr. Sean Hayden agreed and also asked the Board to reconsider trying to work things out with the current program. He shared his concerns about the change and the effect on all the athletes, from Eastland and West Carroll. Both parents thanked the Board for their time and consideration

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

## > Consider and Approve Athletic Sharing Agreement for Wrestling

The Board discussed the proposed wrestling cooperative change. Superintendent Kashner thanked the Hayden family for their passion and understood their point of view. He continued by saying that he feels moving wrestling cooperative partners will be a better fit for our students and district. Travel arrangements and IHSA classification were also discussed. Member Waller asked if this was time sensitive or could it be discussed at May's meeting. Superintendent Kashner shared that the other members of the new co-op have already approved or will be approving tonight but in theory, the

decision could wait if the Board decided to. Members Henze and Cassens both talked about the contractual interpretation disconnect between the District's of the current agreement. They are concerned with how it seems to be an issue even after trying to address it multiple times in the past several years. Lastly, Superintendent Kashner shared that he wished he would have met with the wrestlers in advance before the move became public and apologized for that oversight. He stated that he will be meeting with the wrestlers before the end of this week.

A motion was made by <u>Heldt</u> and seconded by <u>Snider</u> to approve the athletic sharing agreement between Polo, Forrestville Valley, Chadwick-Milledgeville and Eastland Schools to facilitate a high school and junior high wrestling program for two years, 2022 and 2023 winter seasons, as presented.

Roll call vote showed Cassens, Heldt, Henze, Preston, and Snider voting aye. Sturtevant, and Waller voting nay. **Motion carried.**

A motion was made by <u>Heldt</u> and seconded by <u>Waller</u> to approve personnel as follows:

- Approve the hiring of <u>Lindsay Guinand</u> as Elementary Music Teacher for the 2021-22 school year.
- Accept the resignation of **Brian Barr**, as 2nd shift Elementary Custodian.
- Approve the posting for three summer school facilitators.
- Approve the posting for an EES Custodian.

Roll call vote showed Cassens, Heldt, Henze, Preston, Snider, Sturtevant, and Waller voting aye. **Motion carried.**
