#### **SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:**

In the Superintendent's report, Superintendent Kashner shared standard-based grading student achievement data for Kindergarten through 8th grade. Scores in the 2.8-3.4 level show proficiency, and the average for Kindergarten through 8th grade in each of the subject areas showed high scores. The average end of the year scores are listed below:

Reading/Literature - 3.2 Language - 3.0 Math - 3.2 Reading for Information 3.0 Science - 3.2

He complimented students, teachers, and administrators for their incredible work this year to produce these terrific results. Superintendent Kashner shared updates on planning for the upcoming school year. He stated that the district is waiting for guidance from the ISBE regarding masks and other Covid-19 related mitigation efforts and is hopeful that the mask mandate will be removed. Additionally, he commented that the district will be reviewing assessments this summer, and looking at ways to ensure instructional time is prioritized. The recent sexual education curriculum mandate passed at the state level was discussed. Superintendent Kashner commented that districts have local control over the way the standards are taught and expects that teachers and administrators will work together to give a recommendation to our curriculum committee to make it effective and appropriate for our students.

#### **RECOGNITION OF VISITORS:**

Visitors introduced themselves and were welcomed. Kara Sword addressed the Board and asked if there was a way for the school board to advocate to not wear masks and what the ramifications would be to not follow a mandate. Additionally, she encouraged the district to be mindful of the sexual education curriculum and how that will affect our students.

School registration procedures were shared along with the PreK board report. Superintendent Kashner shared that the best way for the board to advocate for the district is to contact their local legislator to share their thoughts.
