➢ <u>FIRST READING OF CRISIS PLAN</u>

The Emergency/Crisis Plan is an annual report outlining procedures in the case of events. Superintendent Kashner shared that the team will continue to meet on a regular basis to provide updates as needed.

> <u>FIRST READING OF RISK MANAGEMENT PLAN</u>

The Risk Management Plan is a required document to levy in the Tort fund. The risk management plan outlines what the district will spend allocated funds on. Superintendent Kashner shared that the majority of the funds will be spent on the school resource officer, intercom and phone systems, and keyless entry resources.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:

In the Superintendent report, construction timelines were shared. Dr. Kashner shared that the front entrance project, second floor renovations, HVAC and parking lot are all scheduled to be completed on time. Dr. Kashner complimented the staff for their flexibility to ensure these projects are completed as smoothly as possible.

Superintendent Kashner shared an update on funding for Whiteside's CEO program. In June, the BOE heard a request from four Eastland students that will be attending the program requesting financial assistance for transportation. Superintendent Kashner shared that he has secured a minimum of \$3,500 dollars from grants and businesses.
