Illinois law requires a school district to notify the parent or guardian of a child who engages in
aggressive behavior, including such behaviors as bullying (105 ILCS 5/10-20.14). The School Board
policy prohibits a student while at school from engaging in aggressive behavior that causes physical
or psychological harm to someone else and/or urging other students to engage in such conduct.
Prohibited aggressive behavior includes, without limitation, the use of violence, force, noise,
coercion, threats, intimidation, fear, bullying, or other comparable conduct. This early notification is
intended to help all of us work together to avoid repetition of the behavior.
